



### Barn Buddy Youth Enrichment Program Referral

The Barn Buddy program pairs up a children with youth mentors, horses and adult skills trainers. The weekly, 75-minute lessons teach kids how to handle and care for horses. Students can join for one session or continue for the full two years.

The Program is unable to take kids who have committed crimes or a history of violent or fire-starting behaviors. If kids have sexually-reactive behaviors or a history of other behaviors that could put our staff in a compromising situation, it must be discussed with the program director and a responsible adult may need to stay during the sessions.
