Our mission is to provide accessible equine programs focusing on life-skill development for all individuals, including at-risk youth and people with intellectual and developmental disabilities. Funds raised at the benefit will directly support Sande School of Horsemanship's two enrichment programs designed to build life skills for our fellow community members facing significant challenges:

- Youth Leadership (Formerly known as Barn Buddies)

 This program provides equine therapy focused on social-emotional learning to kids ages 8 18. Most of the students in our Level 1 classes have experienced significant childhood trauma, with 75% currently or formerly in foster care. Students work on forming a relationship with horses involving mutual trust and respect while learning care-taking, handling, and riding techniques in weekly sessions.
- Therapeutic Riding for students with Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities
 About 30% of our students experience some form of disability, including Autism, Cerebral Palsy, Down's syndrome, ADHD, Processing Delays and Brain Injuries. We offer therapeutic riding to help build strength, flexibility, coordination, confidence, communication, and daily life skills.
